



**REPORT ON THE ACTIVITIES OF NSS
GOVERNMENT KOLASIB COLLEGE DURING
JULY 2021 - JUNE 2022**



During July 2021- June 2022 academic year, the four Programme Officers in charge of the NSS Unit, Govt. Kolasib College are:

1. F. Malsawmtluanga, Assistant Professor, Dept of Political Science, Govt. Kolasib College.
2. Vanlalmangaihi, Assistant Professor, Dept of History, Govt. Kolasib College.

1.REGULAR ACTIVITIES (July 2021 – June 2022)

1.1 Blood Donation.

a) On 24th September, 2021 i.e. N.S.S Foundation Day, 29 volunteers (20 male and 9 female) from Government Kolasib College donated blood at District Hospital, Kolasib.

d) On 1st October 2021 i.e. World Blood Donor Day, Voluntary Blood Donation for District Hospital Kolasib, was conducted at the hospital. It was organised by Government Kolasib College N.S.S. Units and a total of 15 volunteers (12 male and 3 female) from the College donated blood on this occasion.

c) On 17th March, 2022 Voluntary Blood Donation for District Hospital, Kolasib was conducted at the hospital which was organised by Government Kolasib College N.S.S. Units. A total of 39 volunteers (28 male and 11 female) from the College donated their blood on this occasion.

(During the year 2021-2022, NSS Units, Government Kolasib College donated a total of 132 units of blood.)

1.3 Plantation Activities :

a) On 1.10.2021, Cleaning and clearing of the Tree Plantation site at the Regional Sports Training Centre at Saidan Kolasib were carried out. Fencing and cleaning of our surviving tree saplings are also done on this day.

1.4. Programme Officer`s Activities.

a) F.Malsawmtluanga P.O and Vanlalmangaihi P.O attended an online Meeting cum Briefing of NSS Programme officers of all institutions within Mizoram on 17th December (Friday 2021) from 7.30 p.m - 9.00 p.m.

1.5. Observance of Important Days.

- a) On 24th September 2021, N.S.S Foundation Day was celebrated by donating blood at District Hospital, Kolasib. 29 units of blood were donated by N.S.S. volunteers (20 male and 9 female) from Government Kolasib College.
- b) 1st October 2021 was celebrated as World Blood Donor Day. It was observed by donating blood at District Hospital, Kolasib. 15 units of blood were donated by N.S.S. volunteers (12 male and 3 female) from Government Kolasib College.

2. SPECIAL CAMPING

Special Campings with the theme “Water Conservation” were held at the following venues during 2021-2022:

2.1. *Meidum* : Special Camping was held at Meidum , Kolasib District which was about 53 Kms from the College campus for the Renovation of the Public Water Point and public bathroom at Meidum Vengthlang during 6th – 12th December 2021. Fifty N.S.S. volunteers with two Programme Officers renovated the public water point. Volunteers distributed pamphlets among the villagers – containing a note regarding the importance of water conservation.

2.2. *North Chhimluang* : At North Chhimluang, Kolasib District, 62 kms from the college campus, the renovation of the Public urinal was carried out from 6th – 12th December 2021. Fifty N.S.S. volunteers with two Programme Officers renovated the public urinal.

2.3 *Bilkhawthlir* : At Bilkhawthlir, Kolasib District, 50 km from the college campus, Renovation of Public Urinals was carried out from 17th – 23rd January 2022. Fifty N.S.S. volunteers with two Programme Officers renovated the public urinal.

2.4 *Bairabi North*: At Bairabi North, Kolasib District, 62k.m from the college campus, Construction of Public Urinal was carried out from 17th – 23rd January 2022. Fifty N.S.S. volunteers with two Programme Officers renovated the public urinal.

Programme Officers, NSS volunteers, and Local/Village volunteers actively participated in all the above-mentioned special camping.

3. OTHER ACTIVITIES:

3.1 . On 13th September 2021 N.S.S. Govt. Kolasib College units organised an online orientation programme for the 1st-semester students. In this programme, Dr.Benjamin L. Saitluanga, Programme Co-ordinator, N.S.S. Cell, MZU was invited as a resource person.

3.2 . As per the request from the Programme Co-ordinator, N.S.S. Cell, Mizoram University, *Azadika Amrit Mahotsav* (ie celebration of India's Independence) was celebrated (online) on 18th September 2021. In this programme, resource person Mr.Joseph Lalzarliana, Assistant Professor, Department of History and Ethnography, Mizoram University, delivered a speech on a given topic.

3.3 . On 6th January 2022, 7 N.S.S. volunteers participated in the essay write-up/writing competition for the National Youth Festival.

3.4 . On 12th January 2022. 20 N.S.S. volunteers from Govt. Kolasib College participated in the National Youth Festival which was conducted in an online mode.

3.5 . On 26th February 2022, three N.S.S. Volunteers from Govt. Kolasib College participated in the state-level competition for the National Youth Parliament.

3.6 On 10th-11th March 2022, Malsawmdawngliani, 6th Semester. N.S.S. volunteer from Govt. Kolasib College, was selected as a delegate to represent NSS at the National Youth Parliament which was held at the Central hall of Parliament in New Delhi. She, along with two other NYK volunteers represented the State of Mizoram at this event.

3.7 On 10th June,2022.Green Mizoram Day was observed by cleaning and clearing plantation site at the Regional Sports Training Centre , Saidan,Kolasib.16 Volunteers(5 males + 11 females) and 4 Programme Officers participated in this programme
