- (a) **Mode of teaching.** The Committee is to look into the various options to deliver teaching to the students whether offline or online mode is feasible, and to look into the challenges and solutions thereof.
- (b) Preparation of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs). The Committee is required to devise a means for the teachers to prepare a MCQ bank for the students, since the Semester examinations will be conducted using MCQs.
- (c) **Student Identity and Attendance.** The Committee is to make Classwise Whatsapp groups for easy contact with Students. Class Attendance is also to be taken regularly.

- 3. **Resolution-2: Office attendance during pandemic.** The Committee resolved that the strict measures such as (a) wearing of masks at all times, (b) temperature checks, and (c) maintaining social distancing at all times is to be enforced at all times. Sharing of food at mealtimes/lunch etc is to be avoided at all costs. The staff are to be advised to inform the College authority in case of suspected contact or illness, and to take all precautionary measures.
- 4. **Resolution-3: Monitoring of College activities through pandemic.** Due to the pandemic, many activities of the College will be curtailed, and the IQAC resolves to monitor the various activities of the College via Whatsapp groups.
- Resolution-4: Action Plan for 2020-2021: 1). To upgrade teachers' knowledge on online teaching methods.2). To reach out to students with limited internet access.

- 1. The Principal Dr C. Lalmuankima chaired the meeting.
- 2. Agenda-1: Review of Teaching-Learning activities. The Committee reviewed the measures and strategy adopted by the Academic Committee to look into the conduct of teaching-learning during the Covid pandemic.
 - (a) **Teaching conducted online.** The Chairman reported that classes have commenced in online mode. Teachers are free to use the Google Meet, Zoom, and other conference platforms to conduct teaching.
 - (b) Orientation for First Year students. An interaction of First Year/Semester Fresher students with Teaching Faculty was conducted batchwise due to pandemic, wherein familiarization with examination norms and online learning using Google Meet, Zoom, etc. platforms was given. Besides, students were also appraised on etiquette on social media platforms.
 - (c) Training on preparing MCQs using Google Forms. Since many of the teachers are used to the traditional offline mode of classroom teaching, a training was conducted by Mr Lalrinchhana, Assistant Professor, Computer Sciences & Applications, on using Google Forms to prepare multiple choice questions (MCQs).
 - (d) **Student loans.** The Chairman reported that four (4) students had registered for the ensuing Semester; however, due to Covid pandemic they were facing shortage of funds for their study.

Resolution-1. It was resolved that the financial assistance be provided to four (4) students by writing off their loans amounting to Rs. 14,580 (Rupees Fourteen thousand five hundred eighty) only.
